The Safety and Health Hall of Fame International (SHHOFI) is dedicated to recognizing acclaimed safety and health leaders and pioneers for their innovative contributions and service to saving lives. With that goal in mind, the SHHOFI Selection Committee is pleased to open the Nomination Process for the Class of 2011.

We wish to emphasize the need for organizations to clearly illustrate that each nominee demonstrates a very high lifetime standard of achievement or an outstanding effort to save a life.

Note: the restriction limiting the number of individuals per year that organizations can nominate has been withdrawn. Organizations may now nominate more than one person per year for induction into the Safety and Health Hall of Fame International.

Criteria for Selection

Individuals who have diligently served the cause of safety, health, and/or the environment through service, contributions, inventions, and/or procedures or in any manner considered as being worthy of recognition shall be considered for selection into the Safety and Health Hall of Fame International. Please be sure to complete the nomination form and the criterion support information form.

Requirements for the selection process

8 copies of each of the following:

If your nominee is selected, the additional items listed below will be required. The selected nominee will be notified by telephone.

One 5"x7" black/white, front view of face for press release.
- Photographs (3), for use by plaque artist
Front view of face.
Left profile of head.
Right profile of head.
- Information for Induction Ceremony program Statement (to be submitted on a separate sheet)

Criterion Support Information

Meeting the requirements of category's one (*1) and three (*3) of the five (5) criteria of professional activity as listed below are required for submission of a candidate for consideration by the Selection Committee. The following format for supporting information will provide material vital to the Committee's considerations. The application will not be accepted if it does not follow the format listed below (on separate sheets of paper).

***1. Summary of major accomplishments**

A brief summary (100 words or less on a single page of 12 point type) to describe a candidate's major accomplishments in safety, health, and environment.

2. Innovative contributions

Specific contributions for which the nomination is being presented, with reasons for perceived significance. (To effect a change; to do something in a new way; a new idea, method or device. Examples include: invention of the three-point safety belt, invention of the sprinkler system, development of safety program evaluation, ect.)

***3. Research and writing**

Contributed significantly in the areas of research and/or publications. (Examples include: original research answering specific questions or contributing to amelioration of safety, health, or environmental problems. Publication of refereed articles in professional journals, publication of texts or books in these areas.)

4. Server Safety, Health, and/or Environmental Organizations

Provided service and leadership to one or more professional safety, health, or environmental organizations. (Examples of this include: serving as an officer or a board member, committee chair, executive director, ect.)

5. Application results

Has achieved significant results in the reduction of death and injury due to accidents or occupational disease by applying new knowledge and techniques on an ongoing basis. (Examples include: development of safety programs, devices, and subsequent utilization of those in safety programming.)

PLEASE NOTE: Only Section 1, "Summary of major accomplishments", has a restriction on the amount of text that can be submitted in support of individual nominees. All other sections may contain any and all supportive information necessary to give the Selection Committee the most complete documentation for your candidate's nomination.
